

INATEINTEPRODUCT DATA SHEET

INATEINTE is a range of solvent soluble wood stains and tints used for enhancing the appearance of wood.

 Available as a range of different base tints – Example Mahogany, Walnut, Dark Oak, Teak Brown, Black.

USAGE

- For tinting bare wood in the decorative and handicraft sector.
- For enhancing and improving the appearance of timber used in the furniture industry.
- As wood stains miscible with solvent based wood sealers.
- For interior use.

Note: INATEINTE dyes should not be used on timbers which are exposed to direct sunlight. They will tend to fade out.

Some tints may discolour in the short or medium term when **INATEINTE** is mixed with acidic products such as those from the **ACID CATALYSED** range. It is advisable to check for discoloration before proceeding.

APPLICATION

- Surface preparation: Wood Should be Clear and Dry
- Application method: Apply INATEINTE uniformly by brush, cloth pad or conventional spray onto base wood. After checking compatibility, INATEINTE can also be mixed to solvent based wood sealers to obtain wood stains for application by brush or conventional spray.
- **Dilution:** Not recommended. Dilute with Two pack Acrylic Thinner to lower the tinting strength if necessary.
- Spreading rate / Film thickness: Not applicable.
- Drying time: Approximately 5 10 minutes
- Cleaning solvent: Two Pack Acrylic Thinner
- Preceding coat: None.
- Subsequent coat: Any clear wood sealer or topcoat.

SAFETY

- **INATEINTE** is flammable, keep away from ignition source. Do not smoke whilst using.
- Wear adequate protective equipment during application, remove splashes from skin with soap and water. In case of contact with eyes, rinse with ample water and seek medical advice if necessary.
- Ensure good ventilation during application and drying.
- Keep containers tightly closed and away from children.

MAINTENANCE

Surfaces prepared and painted according to specification will provide lasting protection and will facilitate maintenance. Carry out repairs as and when required and wash the surface occasionally; use mild detergent and light scrubbing to remove stains.
